## What is Fleurieu marine life?

It is a community group who work and raise money to support marine research and conservation on the Fleurieu Peninsula. Funding is also made available to specific research studies or conservation projects within the region.

## What is expected of me as a member?

We meet at 2pm on the first Wednesday of each month at the Distinctive Gardens Lifestyle Village Community House, Pine Ave, Victor Harbor. We welcome you to come along and get to know all about Fleurieu marine life.



**Fleurieu marine life** together with Victor Harbor Dolphin Watch run the local **“Adopt A Dolphin” program**. The money raised, helps with the costs involved to run the boat based surveys, which are conducted by Dan Irvine of The Big Duck. Funding is also made available to help with the purchase of equipment, such as cameras and sound equipment.



The group have recently become a part of the local Beach Guardian Network. We collect rubbish which may otherwise end up in the ocean with dire consequences for marine animals. The rubbish is photographed for data record and analysis, and then disposed of appropriately.

Our area covers the walkways around the Horse Tram, across the Causeway and the Kaiki Trail around Granite Island, as well as the beach area that runs alongside the car park of the Visitor Information Centre.



**Fleurieu marine life** holds a *monster garage sale* every February. We also participate in a re-vegetation program run by the Goolwa to Wellington LAP, and annually deliver the Fleurieu Link phone books. These three projects are our main sources of fundraising each year.



### CURRENT PROJECT:

Our latest project is the creation of a marine interpretive art sign to be installed near the Causeway. It depicts four of our local marine animals, gives their aboriginal names and where they can be found on the Fleurieu Peninsula. A brochure will be distributed in the Visitor Information Centre when the sign is put in place.

The group is very passionate about what we do, and we have a lot of fun along the way! We enjoy many social events throughout the year, plus often host *themed lunches*, which have been extremely popular amongst many members.
